- Decree: Official order
- Annex: to take control of

- □ To obey Mexican laws





- Why did Mexico end American immigration?
 - □ They had not adopted to Mexican ways
 - Did not become Catholics
 - Did not learn Spanish
 - Disobeyed Mexican laws
 - Did not become citizens
 - They were a bad example to other Mexican states
 - They were not grateful for favors they'd been given
 - □ They were afraid Texans would try to make Texas part of the United States

- What happened when Americans made attempts at reconciliation?
 - □ Santa Anna agreed to ½ of Austin's proposals, but when Austin sent a letter to plan independence, he jailed Austin.

- During the Texan War for Independence, who led the Texans?
 - □ Sam Houston
- Who led the Mexicans?
 - Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna

- Describe what happened at the Battle of the Alamo.
 - 1. <u>Texans</u> led by William Travis, Davy Crockett & Jim Bowie Mexicans: Santa Anna
 - 2. Texans out numbered 180 to several thousand (Mex)
 - 3. Travis calls for help, but none arrives hold off Santa Anna for 12 days
 - 4. March 6, 1836 Mexicans break thru kill all (except a few women/children)
 - 5. Becomes a rally cry "Remember the Alamo!"

- What were 2 results of the Battle of San Jacinto:
 - Santa Anna was captured.
 - He signed a treaty recognizing the independence of Mexico.

- What name did Texas take as an independent country?
 - Lone Star Republic
 - □ Republic of Texas
- When they applied for statehood, why did Andrew Jackson deny their request?
 - Because Texas was a slave state and would upset the balance between slave and free states in the Senate.
- What changed this position?
 - □ James K. Polk favored annexing Texas
 - □ Texas was annexed at the same time (1845) as Iowa (a free state)
